International Collaboration and Exchange Program

What?



The International Collaboration and Exchange Program ("ICEP Global") is an international student networking and collaboration program specifically created by students and faculty to promote international competencies in premed, medical, dental, biomedical and healthcare students.

Why?



The goal is to impart skills in leadership and intercultural competencies, so that future leaders can work with each other globally to solve health issues in an international collaborative manner leading to Science Diplomacy.

Who?



Each year over 700 students from 41 major partner universities work on small group projects that cover areas of healthcare typically not taught in regular medical curricula (e.g. Public and Global Health, Health Ethics and Law, International Health Education and Healthcare Systems, Reflection on the topic of death, etc.)

Students are selected based on their interest in future healthcare leadership roles and interest in international research.

When?



The fall program starts in mid-October 2025 and ends May 2026.

Cost?



There is no tuition or fee for any portion of the program, but we expect full commitment once accepted.
